Once a favoured medieval palace, a Tudor Royal Residence, presented to King Edward II in 1305, known as a moated manor, it was transformed in 1930 into an Art Décor mansion by the eccentric millionaires Stephen and Virginia Courtauld. This is an opportunity to get a taste of their extravagant lifestyle and admire the magnificent medieval Great Hall.
